## ASSIGNMENT

The undersigned inventor, Donald G. Lewis of the residence indicated below (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor"), has invented a BREAKAWAY SIGNPOST (hereinafter the "Invention"). Some of the preferred embodiments of the Invention are disclosed in United States Nonprovisional Patent Application Number 11/704,887 filed on February 9, 2007, now issued as U.S. Patent 7,537,412, and Nonprovisional Patent Application Number 12/454,931 filed on May 26, 2009, now issued as U.S. Patent 8,303,209, both under the same title (hereinafter the "Patents").

Roadway Construction Products, Inc., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and having a principal place of business at P.O. Box 326, 1021 Salt River Road, Leitchfield, Kentucky 42755, and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives (hereinafter "Assignee") desires to secure and confirm the entire right, title and interest in and to the Invention.

The sum of \$1 and the Royalty Agreement between Roadway Construction Products and Assignor, having an effective date of September 6, 2016 constitutes good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are acknowledged by the Assignor and Assignee. In exchange for such valuable consideration, Assignor hereby:

1. Sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee any and all right, title and interest in and to the Invention, the Patents, any other applications to which the Patents claim priority benefit, including but not limited to related provisional applications, any other patent applications based in whole or in part upon the Invention or Application in any country (including divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation, and continuation-in-part applications), and all patents which may be granted thereon (including all reissues, reexaminations, and extensions thereof);

2. Authorizes Assignee to file patent applications on the Invention in any country in the name of Assignee, or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable;

3. Authorizes and requests the Director of the United States Patent & Trademark Office, and such patent office officials in foreign countries as are duly authorized by their laws to issue patents, to issue any patents on the Invention to Assignee as the owner of the entire right, title, and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct;

4. Agrees, without expense to Assignor but without further consideration, to carry out in good faith the intent and purpose of this Assignment by executing all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, and all other patent applications based on the Invention; executing all rightful oaths, assignments, powers of attorney and other papers; communicating to Assignee all facts known to Assignor relating to the Invention and the history thereof; and generally, doing everything reasonably possible which Assignee shall consider desirable for aiding in securing, maintaining, and enforcing proper protection for the Invention and for vesting title in Assignee to the Invention and all patent applications and patents based on the Invention;
