**GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST
IN UNITED STATES PATENTS**

August 29, 2016

WHEREAS, Archer Pharmaceuticals, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Grantor"), having an office at 2040 Whitfield Avenue, Sarasota, Florida 34243, is the owner of all right, title and interest in and to certain United States patents and patent applications;

WHEREAS, AIA America, Inc., a Kansas corporation ("Grantee"), having an office at 7835 Parallel Parkway, Kansas City, Kansas 66112, desires to acquire a security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to Grantor's patents and patent applications and other collateral as described below; and

WHEREAS, Grantor is willing to grant to Grantee a security interest in and lien upon all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to Grantor's patents and patent applications and other collateral, as more fully described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and subject to the terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement dated August 29, 2016, among Grantor, Grantee and the other parties thereto (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Settlement Agreement"), Grantor hereby grants to Grantee a continuing security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to the following, whether now or hereafter existing, arising or acquired: (i) United States patents and patent applications (the "Patents"), including without limitation those set forth on Schedule A, (ii) all reissues, extensions or renewals of any Patents, (iii) all causes of action arising prior to, on or after the date hereof for infringement of any Patent and (iv) all proceeds of, and rights associated with, the foregoing.

THIS GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST (this "Agreement") is made to secure the satisfactory performance and payment of certain obligations of Grantor to Grantee and its successors and assigns as further set forth in Section 1(c) of the Settlement Agreement. When such obligations have been satisfied or terminated, Grantee shall execute, acknowledge and deliver to Grantor an instrument in writing releasing the security interest acquired under this Agreement.

This security interest has been made in conjunction with the security interest granted to Grantee under the Settlement Agreement. The rights and remedies of Grantee with respect to the security interest granted herein are without prejudice to, and are in addition to those set forth in, the Settlement Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference. If any provision of this Agreement conflicts with the Settlement Agreement, the provisions of the Settlement Agreement shall govern.

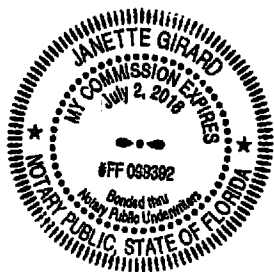


