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PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT ("**Patent Assignment**"), dated as of March 6, 2017, is made by AEP Transmission Holding Company, LLC ("**Member**"), a Delaware limited liability company, in favor of BOLD Transmission, LLC ("**Company**"), a Delaware limited liability company and the recipient of certain intellectual property assets of Member pursuant to the BOLD Transmission Company LLC Limited Liability Company Agreement signed by Member on April 21, 2015 (the "**LLC Agreement**").

WHEREAS, under the terms of the LLC Agreement, Member has agreed to contribute certain intellectual property of Member to the Company as a contribution to capital under Section 351 of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and has agreed to execute and deliver this Patent Assignment, for recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions;

NOW THEREFORE, Member agrees as follows:

1. Assignment. Member hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers and assigns to Company all of Member's right, title and interest in and to the following (the "**Assigned Patents**"):

(a) the patents and patent applications set forth in Schedule 1 hereto and all issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations and renewals thereof (the "**Patents**");

(b) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Member accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions and otherwise throughout the world;

(c) any and all royalties, fees, income, payments and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and

(d) any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.

2. Recordation and Further Actions. Member hereby authorizes the Commissioner for Patents in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the officials of corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions to record and register this Patent Assignment upon request by Company. Following the date hereof, Member shall take such steps and actions, and provide such cooperation and assistance to Company and its successors, assigns and legal representatives, including the execution and delivery of any affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney, or other documents, as may be necessary to effect, evidence or perfect the assignment of the Assigned Patents to Company, or any assignee or successor thereto.


