ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Cynthia Fragale of Kenosha, Wisconsin and Daniel Brueck of Highwood, Illinois (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Assignors") have made certain inventions and improvements in **SPRAY DRYING VANCOMYCIN** (hereinafter the "Invention") for which an application for a United States Patent was filed on January 4, 2012 as U.S. Application No. 13/343,297, which claims the benefit of priority to United States Provisional Patent Application No. 61/429,844 filed on January 5, 2011 (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Patent Applications");

elsewhere in and to the Invention and the Patent Applications, and any patents that may issue for said Invention in the United States and elsewhere; together with the entire right, title and interest in and to said Invention and all patent applications, patents, utility models and designs therefor in all countries foreign to the United States, including the full right to claim for any such application all benefits and priority rights under any applicable law, treaty or convention; together with the entire right, title and interest in and to all provisionals, continuations, divisions, renewals and extensions of any of the patent applications, patents, utility models and designs defined above; to have and to hold for sole and exclusive use and benefit of the Assignee, its successors and assigns, to the full end of the term or terms for all such patents.

The Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks is hereby authorized and requested to issue patents to the Assignee in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.
