ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, DANIEL PARROTT, of 9001 SW 55th St,
Oklahoma City, OK 73179, while
employed by the Government of the United States, have invented certain new and useful improvements in
TECHNIQUES FOR MITIGATING THE EFFECTS OF WIND TURBINES ON RADAR SYSTEMS identified as
ATTORNEY DOCKET NO. FAA 2014-001CIP and described in application for Letters Patent of the
United States of America executed by me on May 11, 2017: and

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States, as represented by the Administrator of the
Federal Aviation Administration and hereinafter referred to as the Government is desirous of acquiring an
assignment of the invention disclosed in said application and other rights and benefits herein granted; and

WHEREAS, the conditions under which the invention was made are such to entitle the
Government under at least Paragraph 1(a) of Executive Order 10096 and its amendments to the entire
right title, and interest therein including foreign rights:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and other good and valuable
consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged:

I hereby assign, transfer, and convey to the Government my entire right, title, and interest
throughout the United States, its Territories, and Possessions in and to the above-entitled invention and
associated United States application for patent including any and all divisional, continuation,
continuation-in-part, reexamination, reissue and comparable applications based on the subject United
States application, and in and to any and all Letters Patent or comparable rights issuing thereon in the
United States, together with all rights of priority based on the filing of any of the aforesaid applications
arising under any and all international agreements to which the United States of America adheres, to be
held by the Government as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by me had this
assignment not been made;

I hereby further agree to assign to the Government upon its request, any and all foreign patent
applications, including any and all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reexamination, reissue
and comparable applications based on any of the aforesaid foreign patent applications, in all foreign
countries, provided that where the Government fails to cause application to be filed in any particular
foreign country the Government shall relinquish all right, title, and interest in the subject invention in
such foreign country, subject to a nonexclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license to the Government in
any patent that may issue on the subject invention in such foreign country, including the power to issue
sublicenses for use on behalf of the Government and/or furtherance of the foreign policies of the
Government;

I do hereby further agree to make execute, and deliver to the Government at its request any and
all papers documents, oaths, affidavits, statements, or other instruments that may be necessary in the
filing and prosecution of the aforesaid United States and foreign patent applications and granting of

Letters Patent or comparable rights thereon, and further to supply to the Government all facts and evidence known to me relating to the subject invention and the history and development thereof to testify in all interferences, suits, and other legal proceedings, and generally to do that which the Government shall deem necessary for aiding in securing, maintaining, and enforcing proper patent protection for the subject invention and for perfection of title thereto in the Government
