PARTIES:

- (2) Element Six Technologies Ltd, a company registered in England & Wales under company number 08206603 having its registered office at Global Innovation Centre, Ferni Avenue, Harwell Oxford, Didcot, Oxfordshire, OX11 0QR, UK; (the "Assignee");

each a "Party" and together the "Parties"

1. DEFINITIONS:

- 1.1 "Application" shall mean, jointly and severally, the patent applications set out as follows:

- 1.2 "Bristol" shall mean The University of Bristol, of Senate House, Tyndall Avenue, Bristol, BS8 1TH.
- 1.3 "Bristol-E6 Agreement" shall mean the Research Agreement as amended by Amendment No. 1 between Bristol and the Assignor signed 14 January 2013.
- 1.4 "E6 Intra Company Agreement" shall mean the Sub-Contractor Agreement relating to Research & Development Services dated 02 December 2013 and having an effective date of 25 November 2013 between the Assignor and the Assignee.
- 1.5 "Invention" shall mean the invention to which the Application relates.

2. WHEREAS

- A. The Assignee is the applicant of the "Application".
- B. The Invention was made by multiple inventors.
- C. Some of the inventors are employees/researchers and/or students of the Assignor, and their property, right, title and interest in and to the Invention and the Application have passed to the Assignor by virtue of their employment or other equivalent contractual arrangement.
- D. Some of the inventors are employees of a Bristol and their property, right, title and interest in and to the Invention and the Application have passed to Bristol by virtue of their employment, and subsequently to the Assignor by virtue of the "Bristol-E6 Agreement".
- E. By virtue of the E6 Intra Company Agreement all the Assignor's property, right, title and interest in and to the Invention and the Application in the Invention and the Application have passed to the Assignee.

- F. The parties have agreed to execute this Assignment for the purpose of ensuring that all legal rights in the Invention and the Application and all other intellectual property rights relating thereto are vested in the Assignee and to confirm the Assignee's title to the same.

3. IT IS AGREED THAT:

In consideration of the sum of US\$1 (one US dollar) paid by the Assignee to the Assignor, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged:

- 3.1 The Assignor hereby confirms the assignment to the Assignee, effective as of the date of invention (the "Effective Date"), and the Assignee confirms its acceptance from the Effective Date, of the right title and interest in the Invention and the Application, and furthermore, as necessary, the Assignor assigns to the Assignee any right title and interest in the Invention and the Application which it has retained, and the Assignee accepts the same. The right title and interest in the Invention and the Application thus transferred to the Assignee includes without limitation:
- (a) the right to apply for and obtain patents in respect of the Invention in any country in the world;
 - (b) all right title and interest in and to the Application and all patent applications, patents and supplementary protection certificates which may now or at any time in the future derive or result or claim priority from the same or otherwise relate to the Invention, including without limitation any divisionals, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, re-examination certificates, post-grant reviews, inter partes reviews, supplemental examinations, extensions, renewals and registrations in relation to any thereof and all and any other rights in the inventions comprised in any of the same (hereinafter collectively and severally "the Patent Rights");
 - (c) the benefit of all priority dates;
 - (d) the right to seek and to obtain registrations in any country in the world in respect of any patent deriving from the Application or otherwise included in the Patent Rights;
 - (e) the right to sue for and obtain injunctive relief, damages and all other relief in respect of any infringement or misuse (whether past present or future) of any of the Patent Rights or of the rights conferred by the publication of any of the same.
- 3.2 Each Party authorises and requests his/her professional representative before any national or regional patent office to insert an appendix signed and dated by the professional representative detailing the filing date and application number of any patent application, patent and/or supplementary protection certificates which may now or at any time in the future derive or result or claim priority from the Application where needed for effective recordal of any such patent application or patent at any national or regional patent office.
- 3.3 The Assignor hereby agrees to execute all such documents and do all such things as may be required by the law of any country in order to record the Application and any other Patent Rights in the name of the Assignee.
- 3.4 This Assignment shall be governed by the laws of England and Wales, and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales in respect of any dispute relating to this Assignment.

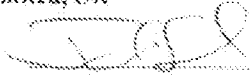

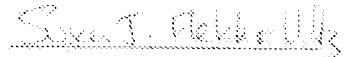
