
ASSIGNMENT

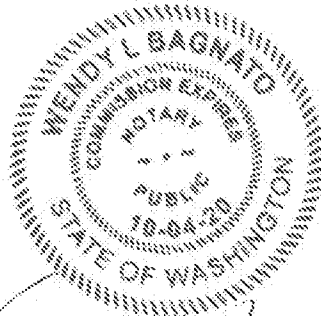



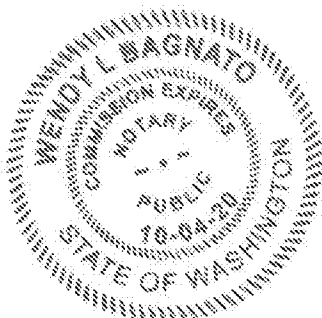
