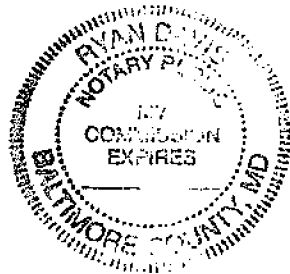

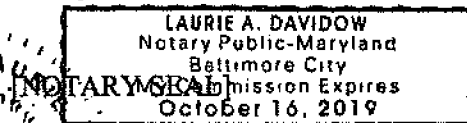

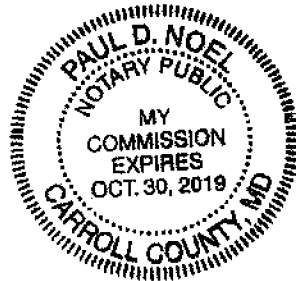

EMPLOYEE PATENT AND CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made between me, the above named person, and Martin Marietta Corporation, a Maryland corporation, hereinafter called "MMC" or "the Corporation", WITNESSETH:

MMC has developed and uses commercially technical and non-technical information which is vital to the success of the Corporation's business. Generally persons in the employ of MMC become acquainted with the Corporation's information and depending upon their jobs and responsibilities may contribute to such information either through inventions, discoveries, improvements, or otherwise. It is necessary for the Corporation to protect certain of the aforesaid information and contributions of its employees thereto either by patents or by holding it confidential.

In consideration of and as part of the terms of my employment or continued employment (as the case may be) by MMC and of the salary or wages paid during the term of such employment by the Corporation, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. I agree to promptly and fully disclose to MMC all inventions discoveries and improvements (whether patentable or not) which have been or may be conceived or made by me solely or jointly with others, during the period of my employment with the Corporation from the beginning until termination, (1) which are along the lines of or relate to the business, work or investigations (including, but not limited to, products, processes, techniques, facilities, equipment and devices) of MMC or of any company which at the time of such inventions, improvements or discoveries it owns or controls, or (2) which result from or arise out of any work which I may do for or on behalf of the Corporation. All of such inventions, discoveries, and improvements shall be the sole and exclusive property of MMC, and I hereby assign to the Corporation all of my rights and interest therein.

2. I agree to execute assignments to MMC or to its nominees, successors or assigns, of all my right, title and interest in and to any and all such inventions, disclosures and improvements and in and to any and all patent applications therefor, and in and to all priority rights as acquired under the International Convention for Protection of Industrial Property by filing of such applications and in and to all patents that may be granted therefor throughout the world. I also agree, during and subsequent to my employment, to sign all lawful papers and to assist the Corporation and its nominees, successors or assigns, at its or their request and expense but without charge, in every lawful way to obtain and sustain such patents in any and all countries for its and their own benefit.

3. Except as authorized or directed by MMC, I shall not at any time during or subsequent to my employment, directly or indirectly disclose any confidential information of the Corporation or confidential information of others which has come into the Corporation's possession or into my possession in the course of my employment, to any person, firm, company, competitor of MMC, or to any others, and I shall not use any such confidential information for my own personal use or advantages or make it available to others for use. All information, whether written or not, regarding the Corporation's business, including, but not limited to that relating to existing and contemplated products, formulas, compositions, machines, apparatus, systems, processes, methods, manufacturing procedures, research and development programs, inventions, discoveries, business plans and procedures, financial data, bid or proposal information, customers and sources of supply shall be presumed to be confidential except to the extent the same shall have been lawfully and without breach of confidential obligation made available to the general public without restriction.

4. All records, documents, and other writings, whether copyrightable or not, relating to or dealing with MMC's confidential information as defined above, and to that of others entrusted to the Corporation, which are prepared or created by me or which may come into my possession during my employment are the property of the Corporation, and upon termination of my employment, I agree to leave all such records, documents and writings and all copies thereof with MMC.

5. Listed and briefly described on the back of this form are all inventions not previously assigned to my former employers, which I made or conceived prior to my employment by MMC. Such listed inventions are not to be included under this Agreement and I agree to promptly notify the Corporation in writing of any projected or actual use of the same by the Corporation which comes to my attention.

6. I agree that MMC may make known to others either during or subsequent to my employment, the existence of this Agreement and the provisions of all or any part thereof.

7. This Agreement shall be binding upon my heirs, executors, administrators or other legal representatives or assigns and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of MMC, its successors and assigns.
