ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Brenda and Larry Stinson, residing at Cataldo, Idaho (hereinafter "Assignors"), invented certain new and useful inventions and improvements (hereinafter "Invention"), shown and described in a United States patent applications for a explosion and fire extraction safety garment, sometimes referred to as a "flash suit", for which Assignors made applications for Letters Patent of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, including provisional application number 60/562,449, filed April 14, 2004, nonprovisional application number 11/104,792, filed April 13, 2005, and nonprovisional application number 12/586,663, filed September 25, 2009, and received Letters Patent numbers 7,594,281 issued September 29, 2009, and 9,055,772 issued June 16, 2015 ("Patent Rights");



Assignee will hold all rights for its own use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors or assigns to the full end of the term for which the Patent Rights are granted or may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignors if this assignment and sale had not been made, including the right to sue and collect damages for past infringement. Assignors request and authorizes the Commissioner of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office, and foreign counterpart officials of foreign patent offices, to record this assignment and to issue respective Letters Patent in the United States and foreign countries when granted, in accordance with this assignment.

Assignors further covenant and agree with the Assignee that Assignors have a full and unencumbered title to the Invention, which title Assignors warrant to the Assignee. Assignors further agree that Assignors will, without demanding any further consideration therefor, at the request and expense of the Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgment of instruments, that may be or become necessary for obtaining, sustaining, extending, reissuing or reexamining United States and foreign Letters Patent or the like for the Invention, and for maintaining and perfecting Assignee's right to the Invention and Patent Rights particularly in cases of interference conflict, opposition and litigation.


