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PATENT ASSIGNMENT

THIS PATENT ASSIGNMENT (this "Patent Assignment"), dated as of September 29, 2017, is made from DuraFiber Technologies (DFT), Inc., a Delaware corporation f/k/a Performance Fibers, Inc. (the "Assignor"), to Fiber Innovators International LLC, a North Carolina limited liability company ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor owns that certain patent set forth in the attached Schedule A (the "Patent") and has intentionally allowed U.S Patent with patent numbers 7,263,820, 7,067,189, 7,021,349, 6,991,850, 6,902,803 to expire due to nonpayment of maintenance fees;

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee are parties to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of September 29, 2017 (the "Purchase Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Purchase Agreement, Assignee wishes to acquire from the Assignor, and the Assignor wishes to transfer to Assignee all of the Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment of Rights. The Assignor does hereby assign, transfer, and set over unto said Assignee its entire right, title and interest throughout the world in and to the Patent along with (i) any and all applications, improvements, continuations, continuations in part, divisionals, renewals, substitutes, reissues or reexaminations thereof, foreign counterparts, and the inventions covered thereby, (ii) all files and records relating to the prosecution, exploitation, and defense or enforcement of any of the foregoing, and (iii) all rights of action pertaining to the Patent, including without limitation the right to sue and recover for past infringement thereof, the right to secure registration of the Patent and of this Patent Assignment, the right to initiate or defend other proceedings before all government and administrative bodies with respect to the Patent, and the right to claim priority, file foreign counterparts and make applications for reissue and reexamination with respect to any of the Patent.

2. Further Assurances. The Assignor agrees to, upon Assignee's reasonable request, at no cost to Assignor, execute and deliver to Assignee any and all additional papers to establish, perfect or defend Assignee's rights acquired hereunder, including executing further consistent assurances, confirmation, assignments, transfers and releases, and providing good faith testimony by affidavit, declaration, deposition or other means.

3. General. This Patent Assignment will be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective successors and assigns, but will not run to the benefit of or be enforceable by any other person. This Patent Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and binding as of the date first written above, and, when delivered, all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument. This Patent Assignment will be governed by the laws of the State of Delaware, without regard to its conflict of laws principles.


