applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for  
patents, utility models, and designs which may hereafter be filed for said invention in any  
country or countries other than the United States, together with the right to file such applications  
and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from said United States application  
under the Patent Laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of  
Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in  
which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all forms of industrial property  
protection, including, without limitation, patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and  
designs which may be granted for the invention in any country or countries foreign to the United  
States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof, the same to be held and enjoyed by the  
ASSIGNEE, for its own use and behalf and the use and behalf of its successors, legal  
representatives, and assigns, to the full end of the term or terms for which Letters Patent or

And each ASSIGNOR hereby further covenants and agrees that he or she will communicate to the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to him or her respecting said invention, testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing, reissue and foreign applications, make all rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid the ASSIGNEE or, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in all countries;

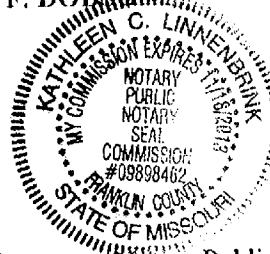
