

all applications for patents that may be filed for any and all inventions described and claimed in The Patent Applications that may be filed in any foreign country and all patents that

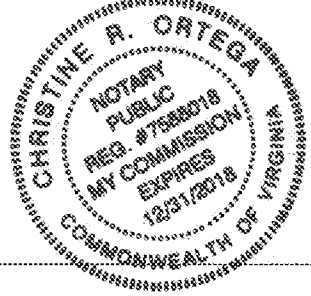
may be granted thereon in any foreign country and all extensions, renewals, and reissues thereof; and




