ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT



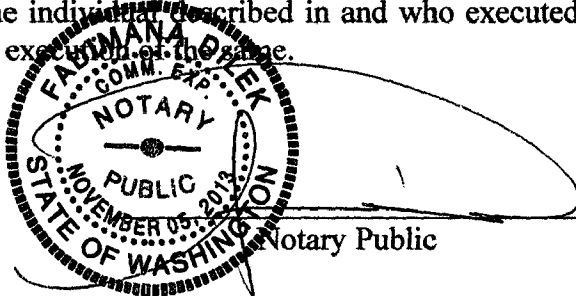
