This Patent and Trademark Assignment ("Assignment"), effective February 16, 2018, is made by and between: Hehr International Inc., a California corporation, having a place of business at 3333 Casitas Avenue, Los Angeles, California 90039 ("Assignor"), and Lippert Components Manufacturing, Inc., a Delaware corporation having a place of business at 3501 C.R. 6 East, Elkhart, Indiana 46514 ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the patents, patent applications, trademark applications and trademark registrations listed in Schedule 1.1(b)(i), (the "Intellectual Property Rights"); and

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property Rights:

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of ten US dollars (\$10.00) and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1.1 Patent Assignment Assignor hereby sells, transfers, conveys, assigns and delivers to Assignee, and Assignee hereby purchases and accepts from Assignor, all of Assignor's rights, title and interest in the patents and patent applications listed in Schedule 1.1(b)(i), all priority rights thereto, all continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reexaminations and reissues thereof, all letters patent that issue therefrom, and in and to the inventions described and claimed therein, together with the right to recover past, present and future damages for all infringements thereof, including, but not limited to, the exclusive rights to (a) bring actions, defend against or otherwise recover for infringements, and the right to the profits or damages due or accrued, arising out of or in connection with any and all past, present or future infringements of the patents, (b) apply for, make filings with respect to and maintain all issuances, renewals and extensions thereof, and (c) all other rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignor accruing thereunder.

Section 1.2 Trademark Assignment Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee all right, title and interest in and to the trademark applications and the registrations therefor listed in Schedule 1.1(b)(i) and throughout the world, together with all common law rights related thereto ("Trademarks"), the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Trademarks, the right to sue and recover for, and the right to profits, penalties or damages due or accrued arising out of or in connection with any and all past, present and future infringements or dilution of or damage or injury to the Trademarks or such represented goodwill.

Section 1.3 Acknowledgement. Assignor hereby acknowledges and agrees that from and after the execution date hereof, as between the Parties, Assignee shall be the exclusive owner of the Intellectual Property Rights.

Section 1.4 Cooperation. This Assignment has been executed and delivered by the Assignor to be used for recording the Assignment herein with the appropriate government entity. At Assignee's cost and expense, Assignor shall execute and deliver such other documents and take all other actions which Assignee, its successors and/or assigns may reasonably request to

effect the terms of this Assignment and to perfect Assignee's right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property Rights, including, without limitation, its recordation in relevant state and national patent offices.

Section 1.5 General Provisions. This Assignment constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements or understandings, inducements or conditions, express or implied, written or oral, between and among the parties with respect hereto. This Assignment may not be supplemented, altered, or modified in any manner except by a writing signed by all parties hereto. The failure of any party to enforce any terms or provisions of this Assignment shall not waive any of its rights under such terms or provisions. This Assignment shall bind and inure to the benefit of the respective parties and their assigns, transferees and successors.

Section 1.6 Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which will be an original as regards any party whose signature appears thereon and both of which together will constitute one and the same instrument.

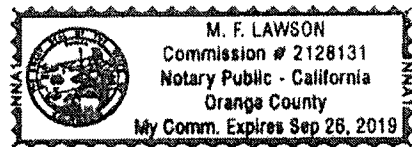



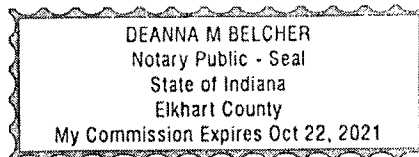
