- * The right and authorization to file any application for any one or more of the Inventions;
- * Any and all applications for patent for any of the inventions that may be or have been filed in any and all countries;
- * Any and all applications for patent that has or may be filed in any and all countries and that has a claim that would be infringed by a commercially viable product now existing or later developed that is based on the Invention Rights (hereinafter "Product");
- * Any and all patents in any and all countries that has or may be granted that has a claim that covers a Product;
- * Any application claiming priority to any of the foregoing;
- * Any application from which any of the foregoing claims priority;
- * Any reissue, reexamination, extension, renewal, substitution, conversion, confirmation, division, continuation, nonprovisional, provisional, continuation-in-part and the like of any of the foregoing; and
- * Any copyright in any embodiment of an invention and any derivative works; (hereinafter collectively "Invention Rights").

Assignor and Assignee hereby agree that Invention Rights exclude U.S. Patent 9,333,993 issued May 10, 2016, CA 2916928, EP 3013671 A1, U.S. Patent Application 15/151,214, U.S. Patent Application 61/840,393, International Patent Application PCT/US14/44412, U.S. Provisional application 61/661,727, U.S. Patent 9,505,449 issued November 29, 2016, International Patent Application PCT/US13/046637 and improvements thereof, including any provisional, non-provisional, divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, reexamination, foreign or national stage, applications and patents to the extent that such exclusions are not otherwise covered by US Patent 7,854,468 B2, US Patent 8,177,287 B2 and International Application PCT/US09/33647.

Assignor hereby covenants and agrees, and to the extent legally possible binds any and all applicable persons, legal representatives, nominees, and assigns, to assist and cooperate with Assignee, at Assignee's expense, in the preparation and prosecution of any application included within the Invention Rights and in the prosecution or defense of any interference, opposition, or other proceeding that may arise in connection with any Patent Property included within the Invention Rights and, further, to execute and deliver to Assignee any and all petitions, oaths, assignments, or other papers or instruments that may be reasonably requested by Assignee in connection herewith.

Assignor hereby authorizes and empowers Assignee to invoke and claim for any application or patent included within the Invention Rights the benefit of any rights to which Assignor might be entitled under international law or under the laws of any particular country, and to invoke and claim such rights without further written or oral authorization from Assignor.

Assignor hereby consents and agrees that a copy of this "Assignment of Invention Rights" (hereinafter "Assignment") shall be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file, or like document that may be required in any particular country for any purpose, including in proof of the right of Assignee to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority and the right to file for patent.
