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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Bernard L. WHEREAS, Corinthian Ophthalmic, Inc., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of North Carolina, and having its principal place of business at 8601 Six Forks Road, Suite 400, Raleigh, North Carolina (the "Assignee"), desires to acquire any and all, right, title, and interest of Assignor in and to the invention(s), the Patent Rights, and in, to, and under any and all Letters Patent to be obtained therefor;

agreement shall bind, and inure to the benefit of, the assigns and legal representatives of both parties;

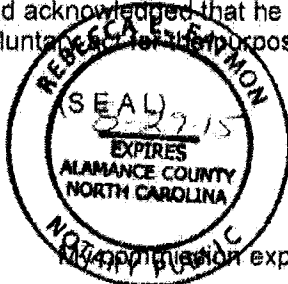



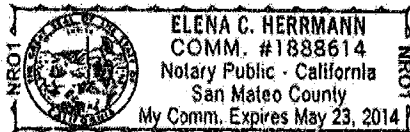
