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PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT (NON-JAPAN IP)

This **PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT (NON-JAPAN IP)** (this “**Agreement**”) is entered into, effective and consummated at the Effective Time, by and between American Family Life Assurance Company of Columbus, a stock life insurance company domiciled in the State of Nebraska with its principal place of business located at 1932 Wynnton Road, Columbus, Georgia 31999 (“**Assignor**”), and Aflac Reinsurance Company, a stock life insurance company domiciled in the State of Nebraska with its principal place of business located at 1932 Wynnton Road, Columbus, Georgia 31999 (“**Assignee**”). Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined in this Agreement shall have the meanings given to them in that certain Asset Transfer Agreement, entered into, effective and consummated at the Effective Time (as defined therein), by and among Assignor and Assignee (the “**Transfer Agreement**”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee are parties to the Transfer Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is made and delivered pursuant to, inter alia, Sections 2.1(a) and 2.1(d)(iii) of the Transfer Agreement.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. **Assignment and Assumption.** Assignor hereby sells, assigns, conveys and transfers to Assignee, and Assignee hereby purchases, acquires, accepts and assumes from Assignor, all worldwide right, title and interest in, to and under all patents and patent applications included in the Non-Japan IP, including those identified on Attachment 1 hereto, together with all continuations, divisions, reissues and extensions thereof and the inventions described and claimed therein, and all United States and foreign patents and filings, utility models, and design registrations that may be (or have been) filed or granted based on such inventions or improvements (collectively, the “**Patents**”), and the right to claim priority based on the filing date of the applications and patents under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the Patent Cooperation Treaty, the European Patent Convention, and all other treaties of like purposes, all rights to sue and recover damages for infringement of the Patents, whether arising prior to or subsequent to the date hereof, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee, its successors and assigns from and after the Effective Time as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this Agreement not been made.

2. **Authorization.** Assignor hereby authorizes the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks (and the equivalent authority in foreign patent offices) to record this Agreement and transfer the Patents to Assignee as assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct, in accordance with this instrument of assignment.

3. **Governing Agreement.** This Agreement is executed and delivered pursuant to the Transfer Agreement. In the event of an irreconcilable conflict between the terms and provisions of this Agreement and any term or provision of the Transfer Agreement, the conflicting term or provision of the Transfer Agreement shall govern and control to the extent of such conflict. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall alter, extend, diminish or amplify any of the representations, warranties, covenants or obligations of any party contained in the Transfer Agreement or the survival thereof.

4. **Amendments.** This Agreement may not be amended or modified except by an instrument in writing signed by Assignor and Assignee.

5. **Governing Law.** All matters relating to the interpretation, construction, validity and enforcement of this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the domestic laws of the State of Nebraska without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of Nebraska or any other jurisdiction) that would cause the application of laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Nebraska.

6. **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in two (2) original, facsimile or electronic counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, both of which when taken together will constitute one and the same instrument.
