ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Peter D. Gunn, residing at Redmond, Washington, John Wiedemann, residing at Bothell, Washington, Alireza Majd, residing at Seattle, Washington, Robert J. Myers, residing at Mukilteo, Washington, and Brian D.
