WHEREAS We, Mei Wei, James R. Olson, and Montgomery T. AND WHEREAS, **Teleflex Medical Incorporated** and **The University of Connecticut**, having an address of 263 Farmington Avenue, Farmington, Connecticut 06030-6207 (both Teleflex Medical Incorporated and The University of Connecticut hereinafter referred to individually as "Assignee" and collectively as "Assignees"), are desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention, and in and to any and all Letters Patent of the United States and foreign countries which may be obtained therefor;

UPON SAID CONSIDERATION, Assignor hereby agrees with the said Assignees that Assignor will not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with these presents, and that Assignor will, at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration but at the expense of said Assignees, execute such additional assignments and other writings and do such additional acts as said Assignees may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the Assignees' enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, divisional, continuations, continuations-in-part, reexamined, reissued, or extended Letters Patent of the United States or of any and all foreign countries on said invention, and in enforcing any rights or choses in action accruing as a result of such applications or patents, by giving testimony in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents, and by executing preliminary statements and other affidavits, it being understood that the foregoing covenant and agreement shall bind, and inure to the benefit of the assigns and legal representatives of Assignor and Assignees;


