THIS ASSIGNMENT is made the 24 day of May 2018

BETWEEN

1. SEMINEL, Bruno, a French citizen of Pomiès, 46100 Lissac-et-Mouret, France AND FAGES, Christian, a French citizen of Donazac saint felix 46100 Figeac France ("the Inventors")

AND


3. The Inventors hereby covenant with RATIER-FIGEAC if and when required by RATIER-FIGEAC to sign execute and do all such further documents acts or
