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CONFIRMATORY ASSIGNMENT

This Confirmatory Assignment ("Assignment") is made as of Sept 13, 2018, by and between TeleSign Corporation, with an office at 13274 Fiji Way #600, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292 ("Assignee"), and Stacy Stubblefield, an individual residing in Los Angeles, California ("Assignor").

WHEREAS, Assignor and Metro Enterprises, Inc. ("Metro") previously entered into an employment agreement (the "EA"), on or about February 2005, in which Assignor was hired on a full-time basis to help develop various technologies incubated by Metro;

WHEREAS, Assignor participated in the conception and development of certain inventions as described and set forth in U.S. Patent 7,945,034 (the "Subject Patent");

WHEREAS, Metro, in conjunction with the spin-out of the Assignee as a separate company, transferred to Assignee on May 18, 2010 (the "Patent Transfer Date") all rights in the inventions and application that resulted in the Subject Patent;

WHEREAS, Assignor continued her employment with Assignee as part of the spun-out entity from Metro pursuant to an Employee Proprietary Information and Inventions Agreement signed on June 21, 2010;

WHEREAS, Assignor wishes to confirm the assignment, prior to the Patent Transfer Date, of all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Subject Patent and other rights set forth in this Assignment pursuant to the EA (or by operation of law); and

WHEREAS, to the extent not already assigned, Assignor wishes to assign to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Subject Patent and other rights as set forth in this Assignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby confirms that, prior to the Patent Transfer Date, Assignor intended to, agreed to, and has previously sold, assigned, transferred and conveyed to Metro all right, title and interest that may exist (whether past, present or future) to any and all of the following (collectively, the "Assigned Patent Rights"):

- (1) the Subject Patent;
- (2) patents and patent applications to which the Subject Patent directly or indirectly claims, or forms the basis for, priority anywhere in the world;
- (3) reissues, reexaminations, extensions, continuations, continuations-in-part, continuing prosecution applications and divisions of any of the items covered by (1) or (2) above;
- (4) foreign counterparts to any of the items covered by (1), (2) or (3) above, including utility models, inventors' certificates, industrial design protection and any other form of governmental grants or issuances for the protection of inventions, designs or discoveries;
- (5) inventions, invention disclosures, designs and discoveries described, disclosed or claimed in the items covered by (1) through (4) above;
- (6) patents that issue from any of the items covered by (1) through (5) above;

- (7) claims, causes of action and enforcement rights of any kind, whether pending, filed or otherwise, and whether known or unknown, under or arising from any of the items covered by (1) through (6) above, including all rights to pursue and collect damages, costs, injunctive relief and other remedies for past, current or future infringement thereof and including rights afforded under 35 U.S.C. § 154(d);
- (8) royalties, income and other payments due at any time under or arising from any of the items covered by (1) through (7) above; and
- (9) rights to apply for, file, register, maintain, extend and renew in any or all countries of the world patents, certificates of invention, utility models, industrial design protection, design patent protection and other governmental grants or issuances of any kind related to any of the items covered by (1) through (6) above.

Assignor understands that Metro transferred the Subject Patent (including the Assigned Patent Rights) to Assignee on or around the Patent Transfer Date. To the extent any Assigned Patent Rights have not already been assigned by Assignor, Assignor hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee and its successors and assigns all right, title and interest that Assignee may have in any Assigned Patent Rights.




