ASSIGNMENT

**IMAGE FORMING SYSTEM, IMAGE FORMING APPARATUS, TONE CORRECTION METHOD, NON-TRANSITORY RECORDING MEDIUM STORING COMPUTER READABLE TONE CORRECTION PROGRAM, AND IMAGE DENSITY CORRECTION METHOD**

which claims priority to Japanese Application No. 2016-159908, filed on August 17, 2016, and Japanese Application No. 2016-171698, filed on September 2, 2016, and for which we are about to file or have filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States;

the sole use and behoof of ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns; and We do hereby agree that the said ASSIGNEE may apply for foreign Letters Patent on said invention and that We will execute all papers necessary in connection with the United States and foreign applications when called upon to do so by the said ASSIGNEE, its successors or assigns, and that We will, at the cost and expense of the said ASSIGNEE fully assist and cooperate in all matters in connection with the United States and foreign applications and patents issuing thereon.

The undersigned declare that all statements made herein of his own knowledge are true and that all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true; and further that these statements were made with the knowledge that willful false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under Section 1001 of Title 18 of the United States Code and that such willful false statements may jeopardize the validity of the application or any patent issuing thereon.
