(a) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignors accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions and otherwise throughout the world;

(b) any and all of Assignors' royalties, fees, income, payments and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and

(c) any and all claims and causes of action of Assignors with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.

2. Recordation and Further Actions. Assignors hereby request the competent authorities in any applicable jurisdictions to record and register this Patent Assignment upon request by Assignee. Following the date hereof, upon Assignee's reasonable request, Assignors shall take such steps and actions, and provide such cooperation and assistance to Assignee and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, including the execution and delivery of any

affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney, or other documents, as may be reasonably necessary to effect, evidence or perfect the assignment of the Patent to Assignee, or any assignee or successor thereto. However, any fees, costs or legal fees associated with the foregoing, if any, shall be the financial responsibility of Assignee.

3. Value of the transfer. For legal purposes, the parties estimate the value of this transfer in the amount of ten US dollars (US \$ 10.00).

4. Counterparts. This Patent Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same agreement. 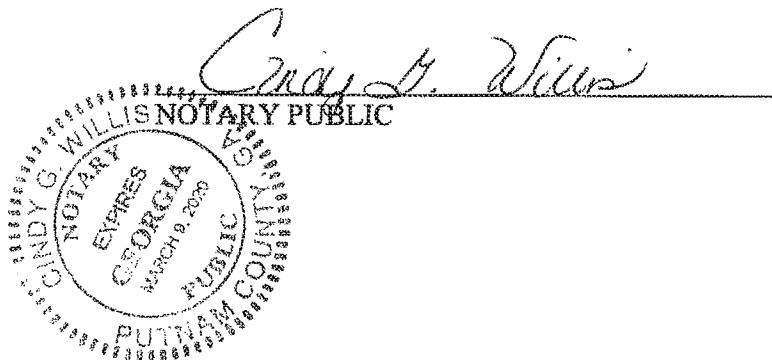
