execute this Assignment and that I have not executed and will not execute any agreement or do anything in conflict herewith, and agree that I will communicate to Mentor Graphics Corporation, or its successors and assigns, any facts known to me respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all documents respecting such applications, make all rightful oaths, and do everything possible to aid Mentor Graphics Corporation, its successors and assigns to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said invention in any country.
