

This includes the need to develop or license a battery charging system and in related molding costs to create a device to hold the phone. The purpose of Samsonite's solution is to avoid engineering intensive, complex and costly solutions to wireless charging. Our solution is to provide a pocket that can adapt to various sizes of wireless battery chargers and smartphones in a way that holds the phone in contact with the wireless battery charger while being carried. Prior "pocket" solutions do not guarantee keeping the phone in contact with the charger, potentially reducing the success of charging a phone while being carried.</p>
