ASSIGNMENT

For the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by ASSIGNOR, ASSIGNOR does hereby assign and agree to assign to ASSIGNEE all right, title, and interest, including priority rights, in and to the Invention and the Patent Applications, in and to any divisions, renewals, continuations, continuations-in-part, substitutions, conversions, re-examinations, reissues, prolongations, or extensions thereof, in and to all foreign counterparts thereof, in and to any Letters Patent and Registrations which may hereafter be granted thereon, and in and to any patent application claiming priority from the foregoing in Canada, the United States of America, and all countries throughout the world (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Patent Rights"). The right, title, and interest is to be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE and ASSIGNEE's successors and assigns as fully and exclusively as it would have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR had this Assignment not been made, together with (A) the right, if any, to register or apply in all countries and regions in the ASSIGNEE's name for patents, utility models, design registrations and like rights of exclusion and for inventors' certificates for the Invention and Improvements; (B) the right to prosecute, maintain and defend the Invention and the Patent Applications before any public or private agency, office or registrar including by filing reissues, re-examinations, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, substitutions, extensions, conversions and all other applications relating to the Invention and the Patent Applications; (C) the right, if any, to claim priority based on the filing dates of any of the Patent Applications under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the Patent Cooperation Treaty, the European Patent Convention, the Paris Convention, and all other treaties of like purposes; and (D) the right to sue and recover damages or other compensation for past, present or future infringements thereof, the right to sue and obtain equitable relief, including injunctive relief, in respect of such infringements, and the right to fully and entirely stand in the place of the ASSIGNOR in all matters related thereto.

ASSIGNOR further agrees that they will, without charge to ASSIGNEE, but at ASSIGNEE's expense, (a) cooperate with ASSIGNEE in the prosecution of the Patent Rights, (b) execute, verify, acknowledge and deliver all such further papers, including applications and instruments of transfer, and (c) perform such other acts as ASSIGNEE lawfully may request to

obtain or maintain Letters Patent and Registration for the Patent Rights in any and all countries, and to vest title thereto in ASSIGNEE, or ASSIGNEE's successors and assigns.


