AND, we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, legal representatives, administrators and assigns properly to execute without further consideration any and all applications, petitions, oaths and assignments or other papers and instruments which may be necessary in order to carry into full force and effect, the sale, assignment, transfer and conveyance hereby made or intended to be made and generally do everything possible to aid **VANDERBILT UNIVERSITY**, its legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in all countries throughout the world;

AND, I/we hereby covenant that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this assignment;

AND, I/we, the **INVENTORS**, hereby authorize counsel for **VANDERBILT UNIVERSITY** to enter above information identifying applications claiming the **INVENTION** as well as any subsequent application claiming priority directly or indirectly to the above-listed applications under 35 U.S.C. § 119(e), including any reissues, reexaminations, divisions, continuations-in-part, extensions, or continuations thereof, and all rights of priority under the International Convention.
