granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this Confirmatory Assignment not been made. I hereby authorize and request the U.S. Patent & Trademark Office and any official of any country other than the United States of America whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as described above, to issue all Letters Patent for this invention to Assignee, its successors and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this Confirmatory Assignment.




