SECURING ASSEMBLY FOR A ROTOR BLADE

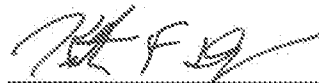

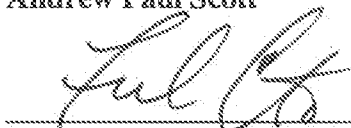

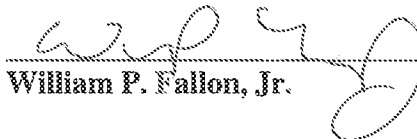
