hereby agree:

1. The Patent(s) right concern:
 - A. The assignor is the proprietor in respect of US Patent Application No. D 668,680 dated 09 October 2012, which relates to a Support Device For Monitor or Display.
 - B. The Assignor as beneficial owner hereby assigns to the Assignee all of the rights in US Patent No. D 668,680.
2. Fees and Payments concern:


