ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS - PATENT ISSUED



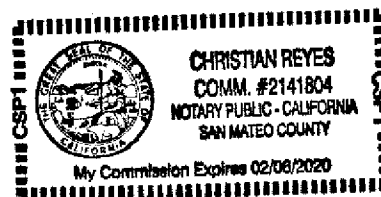
