
NOW, therefor, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged:

8. INVENTOR acknowledge and understand that they have had the opportunity to consult with independent legal counsel prior to executing this Assignment.

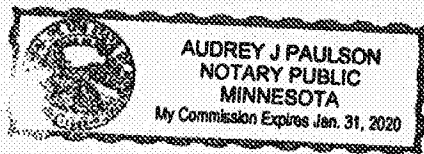


