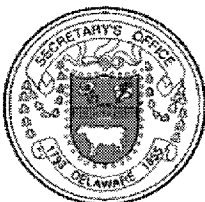

1. Article FIRST is hereby amended and restated to read in its entirety as follows:


"FIRST: The name of the corporation is "Invotas Cyber Solutions, Inc."
