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## STUDENT INDUSTRY PROJECT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

**BETWEEN:** QUEENSLAND UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, a body corporate established pursuant to the Queensland University of Technology Act 1998 (hereinafter called "the University") of the one part

**AND:** The Student (as defined in Schedule 1) of the other part.

### RECITALS:

- A. The University has implemented as part of its course syllabus a scheme known as the Industry Project.
- B. The University has contracted with the Company (as defined in Schedule 1) to undertake the Industry Project.
- C. The Student desires to undertake the Industry Project.

### NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED

#### 1. DEFINITIONS

The following words have the following meanings in this Agreement unless the contrary intention appears:

**"Agreement"** means this agreement.

**"Industry Project"** means the project that forms part of the curriculum of the course. The research question to be addressed by this Industry Project as agreed between the Parties.

**"Information"** means all and any information, knowledge and know-how of any nature whatsoever and in any form of expression, which is disclosed in the course of the Industry Project referred to herein, including all technical information, data, reports, opinions, statistics, specifications, drawings, plans, designs, marketing information and feasibility studies.

**"Intellectual Property"** means all the inventions, innovations, improvements, patents, patent applications, trademarks, trade names, designs, design rights, and know-how which have been created or acquired, or which are in the process of being created or acquired in relation to the Industry Project.

**"Parties"** means the University and the Student. **"Party"** means either one of these as the context requires.

**"Project Results"** means all the data, information and materials generated by the Student as a result of or pursuant to the Industry Project conducted under this Agreement.

## **2. PARTICIPATION**

- 2.1 The Student hereby requests the University to permit the Student's participation in the Industry Project, and the University agrees to permit participation by the Student subject to performance of the covenants herein contained.
- 2.2 During the period of the student's involvement with the Industry Project, the student agrees to carry out diligently such tasks and ancillary work related to the Industry Project as may be requested by the nominated University Supervisor and the Industry Supervisor from time to time in so far as these are consistent with the Industry Project. Unless agreed in writing by the Industry Supervisor, the student agrees to work full time during summer and a minimum of 3 days/week during semester for the term of the project - **10 December 2015 to 30 June 2016.**
