AND DISCHARGING EXECUTRIX

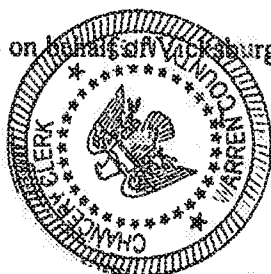
THIS DAY came on the Petition of Maureen M. Ingram, an adult resident citizen of the State of Ohio, whose address is P. O. Box 9785, Columbus, Ohio, for approval of her first and final account and her discharge as Executrix, and the Court, having considered said Petition, finds that the Petition recites as follows:

1. Petitioner is the duly qualified and acting Executrix of the Last Will and Testament of Lindsey A. Dargusch, deceased, having been appointed by decree entered herein on the 7th day of January, 2019, and Letters Testamentary having been issued to Petitioner on said date.

2. Decedent died testate on the 27th day of November, 2018, having at that time a fixed place of residence in Warren County, Mississippi. On the 8th day of May, 2013, Lindsey A. Dargusch executed her Last Will and Testament which has been admitted to probate according to law by this Court.

3. Upon being appointed as Executrix, Petitioner did make reasonable diligent search for any creditors of decedent at the time of her death. Affidavit by Petitioner of said diligent search has been timely filed in this matter. Notice to Creditors was then published in Warren County, Mississippi, in *The Vicksburg Post* on January 17, 2019, January 24, 2019, and January 31, 2019, in the manner and time required by law. Time within which claims may be probated against this Estate has expired. Two medical claims were probated in this matter, as follows:

A third claim was made by and on behalf of decedent's spouse, Daniel Jenkins, who filed Renunciation of Will on April 24, 2019, and Motion for Accounting of Real and Personal Property on May 8, 2019. A Withdrawal of Renunciation and Release of Claim of Any Interest in Estate was filed in this matter by Daniel Jenkins on December 19, 2019. (Doc. #51).

5. The decedent did leave instructions in her Will for all property to be transferred to her mother, Petitioner, Maureen M. Ingram, in ITEM 2 of the Will.

6. There are no estate taxes owing the United States of America or the State of Mississippi.

7. All other terms and provisions of the Last Will and Testament of Lindsey A. Dargusch have been completed, and Maureen M. Ingram, as sole beneficiary of decedent's estate, is the only interested and necessary party to the Petition.

8. This estate has been fully administered except for final payment of incidental VB


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expenses and court costs. Petitioner waives the charging or collection of any Executrix fee. The law firm of Teller, Hassell & Hopson, LLP, has rendered valuable services to the Petitioner in connection with this estate and a reasonable fee has been agreed to and shall be paid to said firm. Petitioner shall also reimburse said firm for its expenses in this estate.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Petition is hereby accepted and approved as Petitioner's final account and that, upon payment of all incidental expenses of the estate, including all court costs, all remaining assets of the estate shall be delivered, transferred and vested in the sole beneficiary of decedent's estate, her mother, Maureen M. Ingram, pursuant to the terms of decedent's Last Will and Testament, free and clear of this estate, and that upon so doing, Maureen M. Ingram is discharged from serving as Executrix and this estate is fully and finally closed.

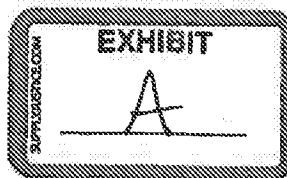
LINDSEY A. DARGUSCH

I, Lindsey A. Dargusch, of Okaloosa County, Florida hereby make my Will, revoking in their entirety any other Wills and Codicils made by me.

ITEM 1. I direct my executor to pay, as soon as practicable after my death all just claims and expenses of my estate. Further, I direct that all estate taxes (including interest and penalties) owed by reason of my death, on property passing under this Will or otherwise, be paid in accordance with the applicable tax apportionment rules then in effect.

ITEM 2. I give all of my property of whatever kind or character, tangible or intangible, real or personal, including any intellectual property rights that I may own at the time of my death (e.g., patents, copyrights, trademarks, etc.), to my mother Maureen M. Ingram, if she survives me. If my mother does not survive me, I leave all such property to my father, William D. Dargusch, if he survives me. If my father does not survive me, I leave all such property to my friend and mentor, Jeremy Kanaday.

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well as (where the context so permits) the lineal or adopted issue of such adopted persons. 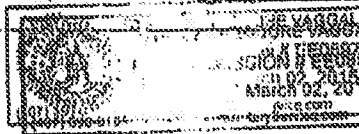
