The Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States is hereby authorized and requested to issue said patent or patents to Assignee.

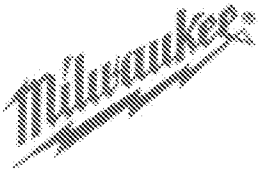

EMPLOYEE AGREEMENT

In consideration of being employed by MILWAUKEE ELECTRIC TOOL CORPORATION, hereinafter called "METCO", and in consideration of the compensation paid me in connection therewith and of the position I occupy which affords me the opportunity to become acquainted with the business and policy of METCO, I hereby agree:

1. That every invention or improvement conceived or developed by me during the term of my employment (or during a period of three months after my employment) which may be connected in any way to the business pursued by METCO or in fields in which I may be directed to investigate shall be the absolute property of METCO whether patented or not;
2. To furnish such information and assistance that may be required by METCO at any time during my employment with METCO and during a reasonable period of time thereafter, to obtain and maintain domestic and foreign patents for such inventions or improvements and to execute any applications or documents that may be deemed necessary to obtain such patents and to vest title in METCO, all expenses in connection with such applications to be defrayed by METCO, METCO to have full and exclusive power to prosecute, either in person or by attorney such applications and any proceedings in connection therewith; and
3. To treat as confidential, while in the employ of METCO, and at all times thereafter, all trade secrets, including shop procedures, manufacturing equipment, and other confidential information acquired by me during my employment, including, without limitation, all specific software, algorithms, computer processing systems and techniques with which I become familiar during my employment, and not to disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, except as required by my duties as an employee of METCO.
