RECITALS

(A) John Francis Cryan and Timothy Dinan, together employed as researchers by the
Assignor, are inventors (the "Inventors") of the Intellectual Property described in

Bifidobacterium longum AH1714 exhibits positive benefits in animal models of

(B) The Inventors have assigned to the Assignor all their right, title, share and interest in

The Assignor, as the proprietor of the IP

(C) hereby transfers and assigns all of its right, title and interest in the IP to the Assignee.

NOW THIS ASSIGNMENT witnesses as follows:

1. ASSIGNMENT

- 1.1. In consideration of €1 (the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the
Assignor) the Assignor hereby assigns, transfers, conveys and set unto the Assignee,
its successors and assigns all of its right, title and interest throughout the world,
including any copyrights and renewals of extensions thereto in, to and under the IP
with full power to Assignee to apply for and obtain Letters Patent therefor in its own
name; and

the Assignor hereby covenants with Assignee that they shall execute all further
documents and do all such further things that may be reasonably requested by the
Assignee and as are necessary for the purpose of enabling the Assignee to make
application in its own name in any Country of the World for Letters Patent in respect
of the said IP.

- 1.2 The assignment effected by this Clause 1 shall include, without limitation, the
assignment and transfer of:

- (a) all patents and other intellectual property including copyrights that may be granted pursuant to the IP in the attached Schedule, as well as all intellectual property that may derive priority from or have the equivalent claims to or be based upon the IP in any country of the world (and including supplementary protection certificates, divisions, continuations, continuations in part, reissues and extensions), and references to the IP in this Assignment shall be deemed to include all such items of property; and
 - (b) all of the Assignor's rights of action, powers and benefits arising from this ownership of copyright in the IP, including without limitation the right to sue for damages and other legal and equitable remedies (and retain any financial award made in any action) in respect of all causes of action arising prior to, on or after the date of this Assignment.
- 1.3 The Assignor makes no warranty or representation in connection with the IP. The Assignor accepts no responsibility for any use which may be made by the Assignee of the IP, or for any reliance which may be placed by the Assignee on the IP, nor for advice or information given in connection with the IP. The Assignee assumes all liability with respect to any risk arising from their use of the IP and agrees to indemnify, keep indemnified and hold the Assignor harmless against any claims made against the Assignee which result from the use of the IP.
- 1.4 Nothing in this agreement will be construed as imposing any obligations on the Assignor in relation to the IP or any liability in relation to third party claims to include be not be limited to claims for infringement of third party intellectual property rights.

2. LAW & JURISDICTION

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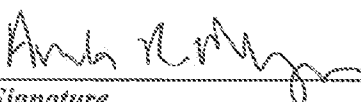
