Assignor further agrees to execute and has executed all documents. instruments and papers and to perform all acts, without any further consideration, as reasonably requested by Assignee, its successors and assigns, to perfect in Assignee, its successors and assigns, the foregoing rights, title and interests, including the execution of any related domestic or foreign application documents.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office (and its foreign counterparts in any applicable jurisdiction) to issue the Patents resulting from the applications in the Assigned Patent Rights to Assignee, its successors and assigns.
