Assignor represents and warrants that Assignor has not assigned or granted any license or any other any rights in or to any of the Intellectual Property to any third party and further represents, warrants and acknowledges that the assignment confirmed hereby covers Intellectual Property created as of the day of this Assignment as well as Intellectual Property created after the date of this Assignment. Assignor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Assignee and its directors, officers and stockholders and the successors and assigns of each of the foregoing from and against any and all claims, suits, causes of action, proceedings, losses, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees) that arise from or relate to any inaccuracy or breach of any of the foregoing representations and warranties.

Assignor acknowledges and agrees that Assignee shall have the exclusive right to apply for, register, prosecute and hold in its own name all patent rights (whether issuing from a foreign or domestic original patent application, continuation, continuation-in-part, division, reissue, re-examination, extension or otherwise), copyrights and trademarks associated with the Intellectual Property throughout the world and all rights of priority which may be available in the United States or under any treaty or convention.

If requested by Assignee, Assignor will promptly execute and deliver to Assignee or its legal representative any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue and enforce an application, assignment or other document regarding the Intellectual Property.

Assignor hereby grants Assignee and its legal counsel the power to insert on this Assignment any further identification, including the application number and filing date, which may be necessary or desirable in order to comply with the rules of the United States Patent and

Trademark Office and/or any corresponding office of any foreign country for recordation of this Assignment.

Assignor requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks (and any similar official of any foreign country) to issue any Letters Patent that may be issued for the Intellectual Property to Assignee and its successors or assigns, as the sole owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to said Letter Patent and the Intellectual Property.


