TURNOVER ORDER

On this day came Plaintiff Point Innovation Incorporated's ("Plaintiff") Ex Parte Application for Turnover Order ("Application") to aid the satisfaction of a judgment rendered by the Court in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant Mediglider Corporation ("Defendant").

The Court, after reviewing Plaintiff's Application, the pleadings on file, the evidence received, the applicable authorities, and the arguments of counsel is of the opinion the Application should be, and hereby is, **GRANTED**.

WHEREFORE, the Court finds as follows:

1. Plaintiff, through its Application, has shown that it is a judgment creditor of Defendant under and through a valid and enforceable judgment;
2. As of the date of this Order, Defendant has failed to render any payment or otherwise satisfy Plaintiff's judgment; and
3. Defendant owns and/or controls non-exempt property subject to the turnover statute as described in Plaintiff's Application;
4. An order requiring Defendant to turn over its non-exempt property is necessary and proper in aiding Plaintiff's efforts to enforce and collect upon a valid and enforceable judgment.

It is **THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that:

1. Defendant to turn over within 15 days of the receipt of this Order, all right, title, interest in its Intellectual Property and all documents, physical or electronic, evidencing its ownership in the Intellectual Property and allowing for and necessary to transfer the Intellectual Property to a buyer;
2. Defendant be required to file an appropriate notice with the US Patent and Trademark Office attaching a copy of the order of this Court to provide notice to third parties of Plaintiff's rights and interest to and in the Intellectual Property;
3. Defendant to turn over within 15 days of the receipt of this Order, all right, title, and interest in any non-exempt Tangible Property in its possession or control to a designated sheriff or constable for execution;
4. Plaintiff shall have and recover from Defendant, its reasonable and necessary attorneys' fees in the amount of \$ 2,000.00, incurred by Plaintiff and which are awarded to it in connection with, arising from, on account of, and stemming from having to file and prosecute the Application against Defendant.
5. That all writs and processes for the enforcement and collection of this Turnover Order, attorney's fees awarded herein, or the costs of court may issue as necessary.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
