QUITCLAIM ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

THIS QUITCLAIM ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT (this “Agreement”) is entered into effective as of March 30, 2018, by and between Sigma Space LLC, a Maryland limited liability company (“Assignor”) and Sigma Space Commercial Holdings LLC, a Maryland limited liability company (“Assignee”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Assignor was formerly styled as Sigma Space Corp. and converted from a corporation into a limited liability company on March 30, 2018, in accordance with the Maryland General Corporation Law and the Maryland Limited Liability Company Act;

WHEREAS, Assignor contributed all of its right, title and interest in its intellectual property, including patents, including all reissues, divisions, provisionals, continuations and continuations in-part, re-examinations, renewals and extensions thereof, and statutory invention registrations, to the Assignee upon formation of the Assignee; and

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of obtaining all right, title and interest to the foregoing, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained in this Agreement, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignor hereby quitclaims, assigns and transfers to Assignee any and all of Assignor’s right, title and interest in, to and under any intellectual property and other similar rights it may own, arising anywhere in the world, including (a) all patents, patent applications and inventions and discoveries that may be patentable, including all reissues, divisions, provisionals, continuations and continuations in-part, re-examinations, renewals and extensions thereof, and statutory invention registrations, (b) trademarks, service marks, domain names, trade dress, logos, trade names, corporate names and other identifiers of source or goodwill, including registrations and applications for registration thereof and including the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby or associated therewith, (c) original works of authorship and registered and unregistered copyrights in both published works and unpublished works, including copyrights, promotional materials and any websites, and registrations and applications for registration thereof, and further including, without limitation, any “moral rights,” “artist rights,” “publicity rights,” or the like which may exist under any copyright law or other similar law (collectively, “Moral Rights”), and to the extent such Moral Rights are not assignable or otherwise transferrable, the consent to use or waiver of such Moral Rights, (d) confidential and proprietary information, including trade secrets, know-how and invention rights including, without limitation, that certain patents described in Exhibit A attached hereto, together with any and all goodwill associated therewith, common law rights, and any right of priority under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, Inter-American Convention Relating to Patents, Designs and Industrial Models, and any other international agreements (collectively, “Company Intellectual Property”), for the sole use and benefit of Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, with such assignment to

further include all of the Assignor's rights to (a) sue for infringement with respect to the Company Intellectual Property, whether arising prior to or subsequent to the date of this Agreement, and (b) any and all renewals and extensions thereof that may hereafter be secured under the laws now or hereafter in effect in the United States or in any other jurisdiction, the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee, its successors and assigns from and after the date hereof as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor had this Agreement not been made.


2. The Assignor agrees that at any time and from time to time, upon the written request of the Assignee, and without further remuneration, the Assignor shall promptly and duly execute and deliver any and all such further instruments and documents and take such further actions as the Assignee may reasonably request in order to obtain the full benefit of this Agreement and of the rights and powers granted hereby.

3. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, and each signatory hereto may sign on a separate counterpart, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one instrument. Signature pages may be detached from the counterparts and attached to a single copy of this Agreement to physically form one document. Facsimile signature pages will be acceptable and shall be conclusive evidence of execution.

4. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of Delaware without regard to the principles thereof or of any other jurisdiction relating to conflict of laws.


