THIS CONFIRMATION OF ASSIGNMENT DEED is made on 31st MARCH 2020 between the following parties.

- (1) **ARJO WIGGINS FINE PAPERS LIMITED (IN ADMINISTRATION)**, a limited liability company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 00961440, whose registered office is at FRP Advisory LLP, 2nd floor 110 Cannon Street, London EC4N 6EU (the "Assignor") acting by its administrators **Geoffrey Paul Rowley** of FRP Advisory LLP, 110 Cannon Street, London, EC4N 6EU, **Alexander Iain Fraser** of FRP Advisory LLP, Johnstone House, 52-54 Rose Street, Aberdeen AB10 1UD and **Thomas Campbell MacLennan** of FRP Advisory LLP, Apex 3, 95 Haymarket, Edinburgh EH12 5HD, as joint administrators of the Seller (the "Administrators") (each acting as agent of the Seller and without personal liability);
- (2) **THE ADMINISTRATORS**; and
- (3) **AW BRANDING LIMITED** a limited liability company incorporated in Scotland with registered number SC634260 Johnstone House, 52 - 54 Rose Street, Aberdeen, Scotland, AB10 1HA (the "Assignee").

WHEREAS

- A) Pursuant to an Intellectual Property Assignment Deed dated 25th September 2019 and made between the Assignor, the Administrators and the Assignee ("IP Assignment") the Assignor assigned such right, title and interest (if any) the Assignor may have had in and to certain intellectual property to the Assignee.
- B) The intellectual property assigned in the IP Assignment included the patents, patent applications and patent registrations owned, used or held for and by the Assignor and used in the business carried on by the Assignor. The Parties now enter into this Deed to help facilitate registry updates relating to certain of those patents, patent applications and patent registrations.

IT IS AGREED as follows:

1 Definitions

- 1.1 All definitions will have the same meaning as in the IP Assignment unless expressly defined in this Deed or unless the context otherwise requires.
- 1.3 Any reference to this ("Deed") means this Confirmation of Assignment Deed between the Parties.
- 1.4 In this Deed:

"Assigned Patents" means the patents, patent applications and patent registrations which are set out in the Schedule hereof.

"Party" means any and each of the Assignor, Administrator or Assignee, together the "Parties."

"Schedule" means the schedule appended to this Deed;

"Transfer Time" means 6.01am on 25 September 2019.

2 Confirmation of Assignment

Pursuant to clause 3.1 of the IP Assignment the Assignor HEREBY CONFIRMS THE ASSIGNMENT to the Assignee, with effect from the Transfer Time, of such right, title and interest (if any) the Assignor may have had in and to, with no title guarantee and subject to any encumbrances and third party rights that may attach to them, and to the extent it was possible to assign them in the IP Assignment, the Assigned Patents, any common law rights thereto, the right to apply for the registration thereof, the right to sue for past infringements (including, without limitation, the right to take proceedings for passing off) together with the goodwill attaching to and associated with the

Assigned Patents. Such confirmation being given for the consideration referred to in the IP Assignment (receipt of which the Assignor therein acknowledged).

3 Exclusion of liability

3.1 The Administrators incur no personal liability under, or because of, this Deed nor any related matter or claim arising and whether the claims are made in contract or tort by reference to any other right or remedy and in whatever jurisdiction or forum. In particular, the Administrators are not liable on any deed or document executed with a view to putting this Deed into effect, whether the deed or document so provides and the Administrators are entitled to have the deeds or documents amended to include an exclusion of personal liability in the above terms. The Administrators act as agents of the Assignor and have no personal liability by acting in that capacity.

3.2 The Assignee acknowledges that:

- (a) the Administrators' knowledge of the Assigned Patents is limited; and
- (b) the Assignee has no claim against the Assignor or the Administrators if items referred to in the Schedule are found to be incorrect.

3.3 The Assignee shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Assignor and the Administrators and each of them, to the fullest extent permitted by law, without deduction, set-off or counter claim, from and against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, expenses, penalties, loss and liabilities whatsoever incurred by the Assignor and/or the Administrators in connection with the Assignee's ownership and usage of the Assigned Patents after the Transfer Time.

4 Counterparts


