Assignor agrees to communicate to Assignee or its representatives all facts known to Assignor with regard to the invention; to testify in all legal proceedings; to sign all documents; to execute all nonprovisional, divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, reexamination, substitution, renewal, and extension applications; to execute all necessary assignment documents to cause all of the patents to be issued to Assignee, to make all rightful oaths, and generally to do everything possible to aid Assignee, its designees, successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for the invention in the United States and in all foreign countries.
