PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT (“**Patent Assignment**”), dated as of November 26, 2019, 2019 is made by TALK ABOUT IT SOLUTIONS, INC. D/B/A REMOUBLE, a Delaware corporation (“**Seller**”), in favor of FOURTH PRINCIPLE, LLC, a Minnesota limited liability company (“**Buyer**”), the purchaser of certain assets of Seller pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement between Buyer and Seller, dated as of November 26, 2019 (the “**Asset Purchase Agreement**”).

RECITALS

- A. Under the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement, Seller has conveyed, transferred, and assigned to Buyer, among other assets, certain intellectual property of Seller.
- B. Seller has agreed to execute and deliver this Patent Assignment, for recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the above recitals and the promises set forth in the Asset Purchase Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. **Assignment.** For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Seller hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers, and assigns to Buyer, all of Seller’s right, title, and interest in and to the following (the “**Assigned Patents**”):
 - 1.1. the patents and patent applications set forth in Schedule A hereto and all issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations, and renewals thereof (the “**Patents**”);
 - 1.2. all rights of any kind whatsoever of Seller accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions, and otherwise throughout the world;
 - 1.3. any and all royalties, fees, income, payments, and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and
 - 1.4. any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on, or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present, and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach, or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.
