4. Inventions & Intellectual Property

- 4.1 It is foreseen that given the nature of your employment and the nature of Exosect's business you may create or may have created intellectual property rights (including, without limitation, rights in inventions, patents, registered designs, unregistered designs, copyright, technical information or know how or similar rights as well as the right to apply for registered protection for any such rights) in the course of your employment in respect of which you will have special responsibility to further the interests of the Company. - 4.3 You hereby assign (in so far as title does not automatically vest in the Company as a consequence of your employment) to the Company by way of future assignment all copyright, designs and other proprietary rights arising in any works or material produced by you during your employment and waive all moral rights arising from any such works or material. 
