INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT ("IP Assignment"), dated as of December 31, 2020, is made by DK Smith International Trade, Inc., a British Columbia corporation, with its principal place of business located at 1465 Kebet Way, Unit B, Port Coquitlam, BC V3C 6L3, Canada ("Seller"), in favor of Global Sales Group Company, a state of Washington corporation, with its principal place of business located at 2537 152nd Avenue NE, Redmond, WA 98052, United States ("Buyer"), the purchaser of certain assets of Seller pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement among Seller, Barry Smith ("Smith"), Buyer, Norio Mitsuoka, and Ryuji Mitsuoka, dated as of December 31, 2020 (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"). Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Asset Purchase Agreement.

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement, Seller has conveyed, transferred, and assigned to Buyer, among other assets, certain intellectual property of Seller, and has agreed to execute and deliver this IP Assignment, for recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office, and the Canadian Intellectual Property Office, and corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, Seller agrees as follows:

- 1. <u>Assignment.</u> For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Seller and Smith in his personal capacity hereby irrevocably convey, transfer, and assign to Buyer all of Seller's and Smith's right, title, and interest in and to the Intellectual Property Assets, as defined in Article I of the Asset Purchase Agreement, which shall include the following (the "Assigned IP"):
 - (a) all Patents, as defined in the definition of Intellectual Property in Article I of the Asset Purchase Agreement, and in Schedule 1 annexed hereto;
 - (b) all Trademarks, as defined in the definition of Intellectual Property in Article I of the Asset Purchase Agreement, and listed in Schedule 2 annexed hereto;
 - (c) all Trade Secrets, as defined in the definition of Intellectual Property in Article I of the Asset Purchase Agreement;
 - (d) all other Intellectual Property, as provided in the definition of Intellectual Property in Article I of the Asset Purchase Agreement;
 - (e) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Seller and Smith accruing under any applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions, and otherwise throughout the world;
 - (f) any and all royalties, fees, income, payments, and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and
 - (g) any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on, or after the date hereof, including all rights to and

PATENT REEL: 055083 FRAME: 0323 claims for damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present, and future infringement, dilution, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach, or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.


- 2. Recordation and Further Actions. Seller and Smith hereby authorize the Commissioner for Patents and the Commissioner for Trademarks in the United States Patent and Trademark Office, the Canadian Intellectual Property Office, and the officials of corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions to record and register this IP Assignment upon request by Buyer. Following the date hereof, upon Buyer's request, Seller and Smith shall take such reasonable steps and actions, and provide such cooperation and assistance to Buyer and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, including the execution and delivery of any affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney, or other documents, as may be reasonably necessary to effect, evidence, or perfect the assignment of the Assigned IP to Buyer, or any assignee or successor thereto.
- 3. Terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement. The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that this IP Assignment is entered into pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement, to which reference is made for a further statement of the rights and obligations of Seller and Buyer with respect to the Assigned IP. The representations, warranties, covenants, agreements, and indemnities contained in the Asset Purchase Agreement shall not be superseded hereby but shall remain in full force and effect to the full extent provided therein. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement and the terms hereof, the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement shall govern.
- 4. <u>Counterparts.</u> This IP Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this IP Assignment delivered by facsimile, e-mail, or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this IP Assignment.
- 5. <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. This IP Assignment shall be binding upon Seller, Smith and their successors and assigns.
- 6. <u>Governing Law</u>. This IP Assignment and any claim, controversy, dispute, or cause of action (whether in contract, tort, or otherwise) based upon, arising out of, or relating to this IP Assignment and the transactions contemplated hereby shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the state of Washington, without giving effect to any of its choice or conflict of law provision or rule.
