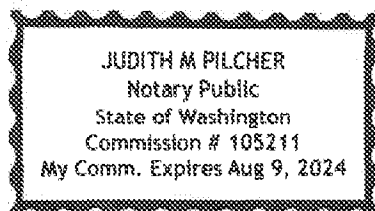
#### ASSIGNMENT
