DEED OF CONFIRMATION AND ASSIGNMENT

together ("Employees") of the first part
- AND** BioGill Operations Pty Limited, ACN 149 810 319, of Unit 15/3 Box Road, Taren Point, New South Wales, 2229, Australia
("Employer") of the second part
- AND** BioGill Environmental Pty Limited, ACN 137 869 740, of Unit 15/3 Box Road, Taren Point, New South Wales, 2229, Australia
("Assignee") of the third part

RECITALS

- A. The Employees, together with Christopher Jeffrey Locker, are the first and true inventors of an invention relating to a "Liquid flow distribution system" ("Invention"), shortly to be the subject of a provisional patent application of the same title. (Attorney Ref: P245728)
- B. The Employees were at all material times employed by the Employer and made their contribution to the invention pursuant to their Contracts of Employment with the Employer pursuant to which their Employer has all of the Employees' right, title and interest in and to the Invention, including:
- (i) the right to make applications for patent or other protection in relation to the Invention; and
 - (ii) ownership of the copyright in any drawings relating to the Invention created by the Employees, together with the right to sue for damages and all other remedies in respect of infringement of that copyright which may have occurred before the date of this Deed.
- C. The Employer has agreed to assign to the Assignee all the Employer's right, title and interest in the Invention and the Copyright.

The Employees warrant that they are first and true inventors of the Invention.

2. ASSIGNMENT

In consideration of the sum of A\$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Employer, the Employer assigns to the Assignee the Employer's right, title and interest in the Invention and the Copyright including the right to make applications for patent or other protection in relation to the Invention and/or the Copyright in Australia or elsewhere.

3. AUTHORITY

The Employees authorise the Assignee to file and prosecute an application for patent or other protection for the Invention in the names of the Employees if such an application is required by the laws of any country.

4. FURTHER ASSURANCE



5. GOODS AND SERVICES TAX



- (c) Within seven days of receipt of the Tax Invoice, the Assignee will pay to the Employer the amount of the GST identified in the Tax Invoice.






