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PATENT SECURITY AGREEMENT

This Patent Security Agreement (this “Agreement”), dated as of March 30, 2021, is entered into by each of the undersigned (each, a “Grantor”) in favor of Wilmington Trust, National Association, in its capacity as Collateral Agent (together with its affiliates and successors, in such capacity, the “Collateral Agent”) for the benefit of the Notes Secured Parties (as defined in the Indenture).

WHEREAS, each Grantor has executed and delivered that certain Assumption Agreement, dated as of the date hereof, whereby such Grantor became a party to that certain Pledge and Security Agreement, dated as of October 31, 2019, in favor of the Collateral Agent (as amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, renewed or replaced from time to time, the “Pledge and Security Agreement”), pursuant to which such Grantor has granted to the Collateral Agent, for the ratable benefit of the Notes Secured Parties, a security interest in all of such Grantor’s right, title, and interest in and to the Patent Collateral (as defined below).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, each Grantor and the Collateral Agent hereby agree as follows:

I. Defined Terms. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein have the meanings set forth in the Pledge and Security Agreement or the Indenture referred to therein.

II. Grant of Security Interest. Each Grantor hereby grants to the Collateral Agent, for the benefit of the Notes Secured Parties, and hereby grants to the Collateral Agent, for the benefit of the Notes Secured Parties, a security interest in all of the following property now owned or at any time hereafter acquired by such Grantor or in which such Grantor now has or at any time in the future may acquire any right, title, or interest and wherever the same may be located (collectively, the “Patent Collateral”), as collateral security for the prompt and complete payment and performance when due (whether at stated maturity, by acceleration or otherwise) of such Grantor’s Obligations (including, without limitation, any extensions, modifications, substitutions, amendments or renewals of any or all of such Obligations):

(i) all United States patents and applications for letters patent registered with (or applied for in) the United States Patent and Trademark Office, including, but not limited to, any of the foregoing referred to on Schedule A, and all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world;

(ii) all reissues, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, extensions, renewals, and reexaminations of any of the foregoing;

(iii) the right to sue or otherwise recover for any past, present and future infringement or other violation of any of the foregoing; and

(iv) all Proceeds of the foregoing, including, without limitation, licenses, royalties, income, payments, claims, damages, and proceeds of suit now or hereafter due and/or payable with respect thereto;

provided, that the Patent Collateral shall not include any Excluded Assets.

III. Pledge and Security Agreement. The security interest granted pursuant to this Agreement is granted in conjunction with the security interest granted to the Collateral Agent for the ratable benefit of the Notes Secured Parties pursuant to the Pledge and Security Agreement, and each Grantor hereby acknowledges and affirms that the rights and remedies of the Collateral Agent with respect to the security interest in the Patent Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the Pledge and Security Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth herein. In the event that any provision of this Agreement is deemed to conflict with the Pledge and Security Agreement, the provisions of the Pledge and Security Agreement shall control.

IV. Release. The Liens granted by each Grantor hereunder shall terminate concomitantly with the Liens granted by such Grantor under the Pledge and Security Agreement in accordance with its terms.

V. Recordation. Each Grantor authorizes and requests that the Commissioner for Patents and any other applicable government officer record this Agreement.

VI. Governing Law. This agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder and any claim or controversy relating hereto shall be governed by, and construed and interpreted in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York.

VII. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts (including by telecopy, .pdf or other electronic means), each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.

VIII. Concerning the Collateral Agent. Wilmington Trust, National Association is entering into this Agreement solely in its capacity as Collateral Agent under the Indenture and not in its individual or corporate capacity. In acting hereunder, the Collateral Agent shall be entitled to all of the rights, privileges, immunities and indemnities granted to the Collateral Agent under the Indenture, as if such rights, privileges, immunities and indemnities were set forth herein.


