ASSIGNMENT

 - c. any U.S. Patent arising from any application identified in subparts (a)–(b), and
 - d. any modification or extension of any U.S. Patent identified in subpart (c), including reissues and reexaminations; and
3. all rights to assert, defend, and recover for any past, present, and future infringement, misuse, misappropriation, impairment, unauthorized use, or other violation of any of the Intellectual Property, including for damages accrued prior to execution of this Assignment and including provisional rights under 35 U.S.C. § 154(d).

Assignor requests the United States Patent and Trademark Office to issue the official grant to Assignee.
